The Federal Government of Nigeria has received financing from the African Development Bank hereinafter called the Bank toward the cost of the Nigeria Electrification Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the Contracts for Development of Solar Hybrid Mini Grids for Rural Economic Development - Minimum Subsidy Tender. "For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the Bank's Disbursement Guidelines and procedures for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit."

2. The Rural Electrification Agency now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders to provide electricity services to One Hundred and Fifty (150) rural unserved communities. The communities are spread across seven (7) states: Delta, Ekiti, Enugu, Jigawa, Nasarawa, Oyo, and Kwara, and packaged into Seven (7) Lots as follows:

3. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), OCBI procedures as specified in the Bank's Procurement Framework for group funded operations, October 2015, IFB and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.

The document will be shared via the Odyssey electronic procurement platform indicated below.

6. Bids must be delivered to the odyssey electronic procurement platform stated below on or before 1.00 pm (WAT), 11th May 2023. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened online in the presence of the Bidders'

designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend online via the odyssey electronic procurement platform stated below on 11th May 2023 at 1.00pm (WAT).

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of the amount specified in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS).

8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Framework requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
